BUTTON	NAME & ACTION
En	Pan (P): Allows you move the image in the viewport.
Q	<b>Zoom (Z):</b> Allows you to adjust the size of the image. Right click and hold.
<b>√</b> \$►	Window Level (W): Interactively adjust the contrast and brightness.  Left click and hold.
$\bigcirc$	Reset Image (CTRL + R): Resets image to original display.
	Orientation Setting: Allows you to change the orientation of the image.
	2x2 Series Layout: Displays the study in a 2x2 layout.
	Cine (SPACEBAR): Displays the active series in an animated or cine display.
=	<b>Show Menu:</b> Toggles the left side menu for viewer version and help wiki link.
	Study List: Toggles the left side list of opened studies with thumbnails.
26	Toolbar: Toggles the toolbar.
$\boldsymbol{x}$	Right click on image to open shortcut menu options.
Ω	Imaging History: Toggles the patient's historical study list on the right side.  Study list filter (determined by date)
